Architecturestudio, is an international architecture, urban planning and interior design firm founded in 1973.

Its offices are located in Paris, Shanghai, Geneva and Abidjan. It is managed by 10 partners supported by a cosmopolitan team of 150 employees.

It focuses on shared knowledge and dialogue to release the creative potential of a team approach.

Since 2024, architecturestudio has been the first architectural firm to adopt the **mission-driven company status with a purpose**:

"To collectively envision the sustainability of inhabited environments through a renewed attention to regions and a committed approach to architecture."

This materializes around 3 commitments:

**Open and share,** dialogue, with all the project team to develop social studies and contribute to the reformulation of lifestyles.

**Collectively design,** co-develop eco-responsible solutions in response to the ecological, economic and social challenges.

**Inform and transmit,** raise awareness and transmit the new methods within the firm, by acting accountably.



## new approach,

**Tracé Bleu** is a holistic approach, devised to meet the new challenges posed by climate change, particularly for architects. Formulated in uncertainty, this approach is built collectively with philosophers, researchers, geographers, environmentalists, artists, art directors, politicians and environmental historians.

Formulated in light of our 50 years experience, this approach projects us into the next 50 years of architecture. It establishes a new approach to ecology through architecture and aims to reorient our relationship with habitat environments, shifting from the logic of land use development to the real management of these spaces.



## new method,

**Tracé Bleu** is also a methodology, original contributory and systemic, that integrates new skills. It should allow us to now approach architectural projects and habitat environments, in all their specificities and complexities to take into account current environmental, cultural and social issues: **resources, governance, economy.**

It integrates new temporalities:

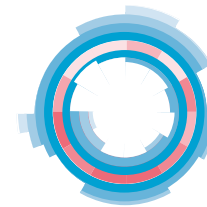
Because they intervene essentially in the long term, architecture and planning should now be more about projection and anticipation rather than easy short-term solutions in the service of better control of resources and a more equitable sharing of uses.

It is thinking about the different habitats and lifestyles over their entire life span and usage cycles, in their initiation, their developments and their interactions, their evolutions up to their future demolition or reuse.

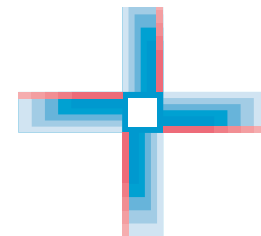

This initiative resulted in the creation of an R&D unit within the firm, driving the skills development of all its staff.
